Whereas:

- the Government's intention to use the suppressive tools of regulation and restriction to promote Canadian content is contradictory;
- giving the CRTC power to regulate online content provides potential for promoting or suppressing individuals or organizations based on whether their views differ from the those held by regulators,
- the Online Streaming Act will increase restrictions on freedom of expression;
- inclusion of phrases such as "gender expression" in the text of the proposed act raises concerns about the Government's ability to regulate faith-based content creators;
