FACT:

Sex is not a social construct but a created biological reality. Gender ideology is fundamentally false and wrongly teaches children to separate their identity from their physical body.



The harms of teaching gender ideology

- > Gender ideology wrongly separates the concepts of sex and gender. It claims that gender is not rooted in biology but is rooted in self-perception and based on social constructs.
- > Gender ideology creates confusion and distress for many kids about their identities and their bodies.
- > Parents are often kept out of the loop by schools promoting gender ideology.

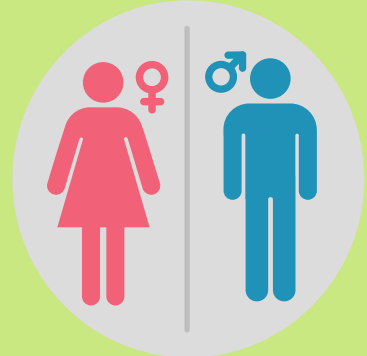
Remove gender ideology from classroom instruction and curriculum materials

Require parental consent for any change to a student's name and pronouns

Allow access to changeroom and washroom facilities based on biological sex
